

A RESOLUTION DISBURSING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECT FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY SHARE OF FOOD AND BEVERAGE TAX FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Madison County Council has enacted by ordinance a resolution establishing an Economic Development Project Fund heretofore on December 6, 1988; and

WHEREAS, I.C. 6-9-26-1, et.seq. provides that such revenue shall be first applied as specified in the state statute, as amended, and thereafter to other qualifying economic development projects in Madison County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said resolution, no disbursements shall be made by the County Auditor from the said account unless approved by resolution of the County Council pursuant to I.C. 6-9-26-13(b); and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Council of Governments, on behalf of the County Council, was to review and recommend projects for the County Council to review and determine funding; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has received the following request for the disbursement of funds as approved and forwarded by the Madison County Council of Governments:

2) Chesterfield:

a) \$75,000 for needed engineering, design, and other fees for the Plum Street culvert project to assist in preparation for a Community Crossings construction grant from the state.

WHEREAS, the Madison County Council finds that the above project will:

- a) Attract new business and/or will retain or expand existing business in the county;
- b) Benefit the public health and welfare and be of public utility;

- c) Protect and increase state and local tax bases; and
- d) Result in a substantial increase in temporary and permanent employment opportunities in private sector investment in the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MADISON COUNTY COUNCIL, as follows:

That the Madison County Auditor shall disburse from the Economic Development Project Funds, from the County portion of the fund, a sum of one hundred sixty-two thousand dollars (\$162,000) to the aforementioned project in said resolution to be applied to the project solely pursuant to the criteria adopted by the County Council in Resolution 89-R-7 pursuant to I.C. 6-9-26-13(b).

RESOLUTION 2023-5B

The Madison County Council (the "Council") met at a duly called and authorized meeting of the Council held on the date set forth below, such meeting being called pursuant to a notice stating the time, place, and purpose of the meeting received by all the Council Members and published pursuant to statute, and the following resolutions were made, seconded, and adopted by a majority of those present at the meeting, which constituted a legal quorum of the Council:

WHEREAS, Madison County has established a Rainy Day Fund to receive transfers of unused and unencumbered funds in accordance with I.C. 36-1-8-5; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 36-1-8-5.1, the fiscal body of a political subdivision may at any time, by ordinance or resolution, transfer any unused or unencumbered funds "raised by a general or special tax levy on all the taxable property of a political subdivision" to its Rainy Day Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to transfer unused and unencumbered funds in the amount of \$1,100,000 from the County General Fund to the County Rainy Day Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Madison County Council, being the fiscal body for the County, that \$1,100,000 of funds in the County General Fund shall be transferred to the County Rainy Day Fund and that the County Auditor be and he hereby is authorized, empowered and directed to take any and all further action necessary to effectuate such transfer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby determines that this transfer and use of the funds helps to satisfy the needs of the County and are consistent with the purposes of the County.

EXHIBIT A

Procedures for Conduct of Public Meetings

The Council, or subcommittees thereof, will occasionally conduct duly noticed public hearings in accordance with Indiana law, at which time citizens shall be provided an opportunity to address the Council on particular agenda items requiring the public hearing. Additionally, at the discretion of the presiding officer, the Council may offer additional opportunities to address the Council on specific agenda items during regular meetings. Whether public comment is required by law or allowed in the discretion of the presiding officer, the following rules shall apply to the conduct of the public at all public meetings:

- 1. Individuals wishing to speak at the public hearing shall fill in their name and address on the Sign-In Sheet provided at the podium prior to the hearing.
- 2. During the public hearing, speakers must give a name and address at the podium and speak for no more than 3 minutes. Meeting minutes will note the speaker's participation and become a public record. Speakers should refrain from making comments that have already been made by other speakers.
- 3. Comments by members of the public shall be directed to the Council and not to the individual or agency requesting the appropriation or to any other person. Neither the Council, county employee, nor any other individual shall be required to answer questions or engage in debate during public comment. Violation of this requirement may result in the speaker's loss of the right to comment.
- 4. Comments must be directed toward the subject of the public hearing. Any comments not germane to the subject of the public hearing will not be allowed. Violation of this requirement may result in the speaker's loss of the right to comment.
- 5. If an individual desires to submit written information, he or she may deliver it to the Auditor either prior to or during the meeting.
- 6. Discourteous, disorderly or contemptuous conduct by either the speaker during the public hearing, or by a member or the public at any time, shall be regarded as a breach of courtesy. Violation of this requirement may result in the speaker's loss of the right to comment, and the presiding officer may order any person who has breached courtesy expelled from the meeting by law enforcement or courthouse security officer.
- 7. Speakers should not expect that their questions will be answered.
- 8. Every person appearing shall abide by the directions of the presiding officer.
- 9. Once all testimony is taken, the public portion of the hearing will be closed, and no further testimony will be taken.
