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MADISON COUNTY COUNCIL MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA RESOLUTION 2024-3A

A RESOLUTION DISBURSING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECT FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY SHARE OF FOOD AND BEVERAGE TAX FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Madison County Council has enacted by ordinance a resolution establishing an Economic Development Project Fund heretofore on December 6, 1988, and

WHEREAS, I.C. 6-9-26-1, <u>et. seq.</u> provides that such revenue shall be first applied as specified in the state statute, as amended, and thereafter to other qualifying economic development projects in Madison County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said resolution, no disbursements shall be made by the County Auditor from the said account unless approved by resolution of the County Council pursuant to I.C. 6-9-26-13(b); and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Council of Governments, on behalf of the County Council, was to review and recommend projects for the County Council to review and determine funding; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has received the following request for the disbursement of funds as approved and forwarded by the Madison County Council of Governments:

- 1) Alexandria: \$150,000 for a downtown façade grant program.
- 2) Elwood: \$225,000 for the municipal golf course irrigation system upgrades and additions.
- 3) Edgewood: \$50,000 for Fire Station/Police Department ADA updates and other improvements (when funds are available).
- 4) Frankton: \$100,000 for stormwater improvements.
- 5) Ingalls: \$170,000 for gateway signage at Exit 214.
- 6) Madison County: \$270,287 for 2024 operating expenses matching funds for Transportation for Rural Areas of Madison County (TRAM) to the Madison County Council of Governments.
- 7) Madison County: \$125,000 for GIS/planning funds for the Madison County Council of Governments (when funds are available).
- 8) Markleville: \$150,000 for a new community building.
- 9) Pendleton: \$250,000 for a downtown façade grant program (when funds are available).
- 10) Orestes: \$50,000 for community park improvements (when funds are available).
- 11) Summitville: \$60,550 for downtown building(s) demolition and removal.

WHEREAS, the Madison County Council finds that the above projects will:

a) Attract new business and/or will retain or expand existing business in the county;

- b) Benefit the public health and welfare and be of public utility;
- c) Protect and increase state and local tax bases; and
- d) Result in a substantial increase in temporary and permanent employment opportunities in private sector investment in the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MADISON COUNTY COUNCIL as follows:

That the Madison County Auditor shall disburse from the Economic Development Project Funds, from the County portion of the fund, a sum of one million six-hundred thousand eight-hundred thirty-seven dollars (\$1,600,837) to the aforementioned project in said resolution to be applied to the projects solely pursuant to the criteria adopted by the County Council in Resolution 89-R-7 pursuant to I.C. 6-9-26-13(b).

RESOLUTION 2024-3B

The Madison County Council (the "Council") met at a duly called and authorized meeting of the Council held on the date set forth below, such meeting being called pursuant to a notice stating the time, place, and purpose of the meeting received by all the Council Members and published pursuant to statute, and the following resolutions were made, seconded, and adopted by a majority of those present at the meeting, which constituted a legal quorum of the Council:

WHEREAS, Madison County has established a Rainy Day Fund to receive transfers of unused and unencumbered funds in accordance with I.C. 36-1-8-5; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 36-1-8-5.1, the fiscal body of a political subdivision may at any time, by ordinance or resolution, transfer any unused or unencumbered funds "raised by a general or special tax levy on all the taxable property of a political subdivision" to its Rainy Day Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to transfer unused and unencumbered funds in the amount of \$2,500,000 from the County General Fund to the County Rainy Day Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Madison County Council, being the fiscal body for the County, that \$2,500,000 of funds in the County General Fund shall be transferred to the County Rainy Day Fund and that the County Auditor be and he hereby is authorized, empowered and directed to take any and all further action necessary to effectuate such transfer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby determines that this transfer and use of the funds helps to satisfy the needs of the County and are consistent with the purposes of the County.
